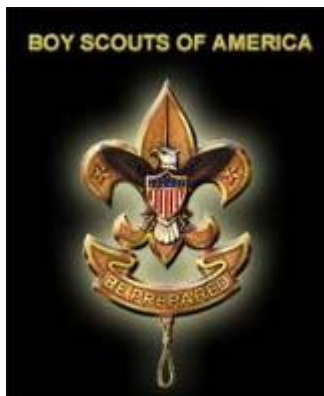
ADVENTURE!

What it costs

Dues for Troop 121 are \$1.00 per week. Dues help pay for registration with the Boy Scouts of America, unit insurance, a book, neckerchief and slide for each scout, and helps to pay for awards and activities for each boy. In addition, it covers the cost of a subscription to Boys' Life magazine.

To help defray other costs, scouts are expected to participate in our annual fundraising activities, including the popcorn sale and chicken barbeque.

There are additional costs associated with particular activities, such as food costs for camping trips, admission fees, etc. Costs for uniform items are also the responsibility of the scout and his family.

How to join

Membership is open to boys in grades 6-12 or ages 11-17 whether or not you've belonged to a troop before or whether you were ever in Cub Scouts.
